

Containers for Combustible Waste Containers are available for the temporary storage of combustible (wood, paper, textile, etc.) waste material free of flammable liquids. The design of these containers is intended to isolate the discarded trash from other building occupancy.

A waste container is a complete assembly of body and cover (head). The container may have a partially open cover which, by design, will contain and suffocate an internal fire; a normally closed cover; or a cover held open by a fusible link which, when subjected to flame, will melt and allow the cover to close automatically.
